Please be advised that in accordance with Tennessee Code 39-15-413 - Law enforcement efforts, Agents of the Tennessee Alcoholic Beverage Commission supervised an individual that was under 21 years of age entering the above location on the above date in a controlled attempt to purchase beer or alcoholic beverages in order to test the compliance of the licensed premises with applicable statutes and rules. The employee on duty requested identification and the individual was not able to purchase alcohol.

The purchase and/or consumption of beer or alcoholic beverages by underage persons is a serious problem in this state as well as across the nation. The Tennessee Alcoholic Beverage Commission appreciates your efforts in combating this problem and effectively training your employees in the appropriate steps to prevent sale of beer or alcohol to underage persons.
